Scottish Health Innovations Limited (SHIL) became subject to the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) on 1 September 2016.

SHIL has adopted the Scottish Information Commissioner's Model Publication Scheme (MPS) and this Guide to Information is published in accordance with the MPS. The guide sets out how members of the public can access published information and lists what information SHIL makes available to the public under the MPS.
